DCA FIELD TRIAL MERIT AWARDS: DCA Membership requirements for Awards will be in accordance with current policy as determined by the DCA Board for DCA Merit Award Programs. Only those points earned for placements in the Field Champion stakes at AKC licensed or member trials will count toward the DCA Field Trial Merit Awards. Points are tabulated using the Delaney System +1 for first through fourth place, based on the number of starters. In the case of ties, dogs will receive the same place award, with the next place(s) being skipped. A minimum of two placements in Field Champion stakes during the award year are required to earn an award, and / or be included in preliminary listings.

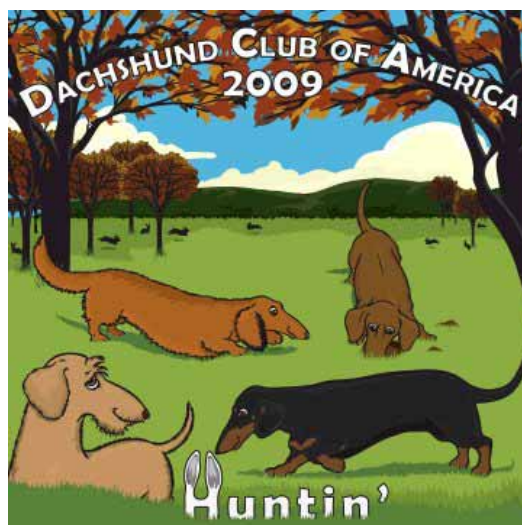
## DCA 2009 Field Event Sponsorships

## Excerpt from June 6, 2009 Performance Events Committee Report to the DCA Board

***Review of the AKC's Dachshund Field Trial Rules*** To our knowledge there has never been a comprehensive review/update of the Dachshund Field Trial Rules and the PEC would like to spearhead such an endeavor rather than going at line item changes as have been done in the past. The suggestion is to set up a procedure that emulates AKC Advisory Committees organized when reviews are done of their all-breed events rules and regulations. The steps are as follows:

- a. Announce to the fancy that such a review is taking place.

- b. Declare an "open comment" period for all interested members of the sport. Comments may be submitted and distributed to all the members of the committee for consideration.
- c. The committee reviews all the input its members receive and formulate a list of proposed changes to the rules. These proposals are presented to the community.
- d. A second "open comment" period is declared for additional commentary regarding the actual proposed wording changes.
- e. The committee once again reviews all the input received and adjusts or modifies the proposed changes until a consensus is reached and a final form is established.
- f. The final proposals are submitted to the DCA board for its review and approval. Once accomplished, the proposed changes are submitted to the AKC Delegates body for their approval as rules changes.

At this time, the only sections of the rules that we are interested in addressing are those pertaining to the management of the trials and/or the procedures of conducting a field trial. We do not anticipate attempting to tackle "scoring" or how dogs are "judged" as it is recognized that control over these types of evaluations can be extremely subjective and vary with judges' own interpretations.

This is not expected to be a rapid process, as the intent is to allow ample time for input and feedback and due consideration of all the points. It is expected that this will take upwards of a year or more. We intend to encourage field trial participants to discuss various sections of the rules in any open forum they or we can create. As for the specific manner by which comments may be submitted to the committee, we plan to establish a yahoo group list that will be created so that any one may post messages/comments but only the list "members" may access them (in this case it is expected that the list "members" will be the committee members and any other interested board members.) It is felt that the privacy of such a list will encourage many ingenious suggestions and genuine thoughts to be submitted by people who are perhaps a bit shy about putting their feelings/beliefs "out there" on a more public list. To that end, we are requesting to use DCA's name in the identification of such a group address (specifically "DCA\_FT\_Advisory.")

**Late update:** The "DCA\_FT\_Advisory" list was been approved and is functional, and the plan is to have it "open" until the end of the year (12/31/09). The Performance Events Department is seeking the input of your Club regarding a possible new Earthdog title – Endurance Earthdog.

**Criteria for Endurance Earthdog title:** A dog must first be a Master Earthdog before it can start earning the legs required to be awarded the Endurance Earthdog title. The title would be awarded to a dog that on five occasions passes both the Senior and Master tests at the same event.

The Department has had an on-going dialog with the Herding–Earthdog–Coursing Delegate Committee regarding an administratively feasible method to handle this addition to the Earthdog program. The following process is a product of these discussions and is supported by the Delegate Committee.

**Process:** A dog would enter the current Senior and Master tests at an event. The participant will record on a form provided by the AKC those events where the dog passed both the Senior and Master tests. Upon accomplishing this double qualification five times, the participant will send the form along with \$30 to the Performance Events Department. Once verified, a title certificate will be issued and the Endurance Earthdog (EE) title will be added to the dog's pedigree.

**Start-Up Plan:** A dog will be allowed to count up to four previously earned double qualifications. One double qualification must be earned after the title implementation date.

Performance Events is seeking input regarding:

1. Does your Club support the idea of an Endurance Earthdog title? Comments?
2. Comments regarding the process.
3. Does the start-up plan seem reasonable? Comments?

This idea is still in the formative stages. It has not been reviewed by the Board of Directors. No timetable has been established for its implementation.

Please provide your comments to me no later than September 1, 2009. Thank you for your input.
